

RECYCLE RIGHT LYON COUNTY

- ✓ Remove any non-paper materials (metal clips, plastic bindings, metal spirals, plastic newspaper sleeves, etc.)
- ✓ Small staples and paper clips are ok.
- ✓ Recycle **ONLY** plastic bottles, tubs and jugs. NO other types of plastic can be recycled!
- ✓ If the cap is just plastic (not a pump or nozzle), place back on if completely empty. Plastic pumps or nozzles should be thrown away.
- ✓ For aluminum foil or trays, make sure they are clean and roll into a ball.
- ✓ No need to crush cans or milk jugs.
- ✓ Empty all liquid and food; rinse if needed

DID YOU KNOW...

Residents pay for recycling through a special assessment on property taxes. This payment goes to the county to pay for the county recycling program.

Residents who live within city limits can receive a recycling cart through the county. Recycling carts that are damaged can be replaced for free by calling the county recycling program.

Community recycling dropsites are located in or near every city in Lyon County and are open 24/7 for residents to use.

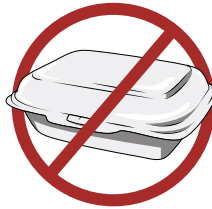

Other items that are not recyclable - **TRASH** only include:

- ✗ Food or liquids
- ✗ Paper napkins, plates, cups, tissues or wrapping paper
- ✗ Non-recyclable plastic-kids toys, pools, tarps, totes, laundry baskets, etc.
- ✗ Plastic pots, plastic flowers, mulch bags, plastic sheeting, plastic tarps, plastic food wraps, etc.
- ✗ Plastic tubing/tiling/sump pump hoses
- ✗ Pet food bags or solar salt bags
- ✗ Dishware, autoglass, microwave trays, or window glass
- ✗ Diapers or cat litter
- ✗ Furnace filters
- ✗ Empty RV fluid or oil containers
- ✗ Medical equipment
- ✗ Small appliances (radios, blenders, mixer, etc.)
- ✗ Empty paint cans & empty chemical containers including empty farm related containers/cleaning supplies

Items that are not recyclable that have other disposal options include:

- ✗ Tires, auto parts & scrap metal
- ✗ Concrete, wood and other construction debris
- ✗ Yard waste (not allowed in trash)
- ✗ Batteries
- ✗ Vinyl Siding & Gutters
- ✗ Shredded paper & books
- ✗ Sharps (needles)/syringes
- ✗ Large appliances
